Minute for Mission.....Pondering on Pentecost

Holy week is over and there are 50 days before we celebrate Pentecost. The question arises, "Are we a Pentecostal people living the Spirit-filled life?"

On the Day of Jesus Ascension, he gave the disciples a commission - be my witness to the ends of the earth. He also told them to wait, and speaks of the one he will send, who will be their Comforter, Advocate, Companion and empower them, so they might fulfill this calling. (Acts 1:4 - 5).

In our time, as we are called by our Lord and Savior, Jesus, we too are in-dwelt by the Holy Spirit. In Ephesians 5:18 - 20, Paul instructs us to "Be filled with the Spirit". Are we blowing our own breath into the sails for our lives or our church? It is our voluntary choice to allow the Holy Spirit to influence, lead, guide and rule in our lives. Take time to ponder the meaning of Pentecost, pray to be filled by the Spirit, and be changed by the spirit, so that we too may witness to the ends of the earth.

The church will have available a few (approximately 25) coin folders for those who wish to contribute to the Pentecost Offering by saving their quarters...for the rest of us who might mislay the coin folder or forget to bring it in, we are encouraged to make our contribution on May 19 in the form of cash or check (in either case identified as the special Pentecost Offering).

MORE FROM THE MISSION MINISTRY:

Those of us who serve God on the Mission Ministry (Jane Minikus, Steve Minikus, Jane Bodden, Luz Porter, Angie Ebarle, Ralph Acevedo, Mary Ann Radler and Pastor Michel) share

a growing concern with the debt load being carried by Faith Presbyterian Church EPC and a recognition that the high debt load impairs our ability to be faithful stewards of the resources available to us...we are not able to contribute to many worthy mission causes that come before us and we are not able to fully fund our own programs here at the church as we "pay the mortgage first". Accordingly,

after discussion, it was decided to encourage anyone in the congregation who may be blessed, from time to time, with some extra funds, to make a specific (over and above the pledge already made) contribution to be directed towards "principal reduction". These contributions will enable us to pay the outstanding principal balance of the existing mortgage in favor of the Presbytery of Tropical Florida (UPCUSA) faster, thus reducing the total interest paid to PTF and getting Faith Presbyterian out from under a debt obligation to a creditor that we do not wish to owe. We will place a "thermometer" in the Narthex shortly, so all can see how quickly we can pay the principal balance!

IGNITE WORSHIP


Calling all high school youth and young adults!
