GLEANINGS FROM THE EXODUS CLASS:

NOTE: I realize that most of you can't attend my Wednesday morning Bible class, so perhaps from time to time I may share some gems from the class here.

God's plan of salvation in the Old Testament: The 7 ðI willö s of Exodus 6-8
Up to this point, God has said that He remembers His covenant with Abraham, Isaac and Jacob and will deliver His people from bondage in Egypt. He has revealed himself to Moses as the covenant keeping God and told him that he will use Moses to lead them out. But, so far, things have only gotten worse for them. So here, God details his plan of deliverance, listing 7 things he will do. The number 7 in the Bible represents completion or perfection. Thus God, here, is giving his perfect complete plan for the deliverance of Israel from Egypt. But, we can also see here a picture of his perfect complete plan of salvation for us. If you look up the New Testament references I have given for each one, you'll see what I mean.

The 7 ðI willö s of Exodus 6-8. Also note that they are in perfect tense in the original Hebrew, which indicates that in the mind of God, they are already done.

The 7 I will's with explanatory Old Testament and New Testament references:

1. I will bring you out from under their burdens. (Rom.7:14, 8:2)
2. I will rid you of their bondage (complete deliverance-Rom.6:6, Col.1:13)
3. I will redeem youô purchase and set free by price --1 Pet. 1:18-19
- 3b. and by power (With outstretched arm)-->Eph.1:19->2:1
4. I will take you to Me for a people (Exod.19:5--> Deut.14:2)-->I Pet.2:9-10
5. I will be to you a God (->Lev.26:12)-->IICor.6:16
6. I will bring you in into the land -->Phil.1:6-->John 14:2-3
7. And I will give it to you as a heritage --> Eph.1:11-14
